New Policies

FSVAA Family Membership Policy

On February 20, 2019, the Board of Directors voted and passed the new Family Membership Policy.

Families qualify for the membership discount rate of \$70 per year. If you are part of a Family Membership, each family member included in the application is required to docent once per month in either one of our two Galleries whether they exhibit or not.

(Example: If you have three family members listed on the Family Membership application, each Member is required to docent once per month in either one of our two Galleries, whether or not they exhibit in a show. Under the Family Membership Policy, this means they need to fill three docenting slots each month. You may designate the same person in your Family Membership to do all the required docenting. If one of those members is a minor, under the age of 18, then another member on their Family Membership application can docent in their place to meet their membership requirement.)

FSVAA Student Membership Policy

On February 20, 2019, the Board of Directors voted and passed the new Student Membership Policy.

Full-time students qualify for membership for the discount rate of \$25 per year until the age of 26. High school students are not required to docent.

These two policies will go into effect on March 1, 2019.


