FSVAA and Social Media

Curiosity

You must create a sense of curiosity of you and your art to other Instagram users that don't know you exist. The way to do it is by starting

to like and follow the # hashtag posts that have to do with your kind of art. Find other artists that are doing work like yours or genres of art that you are interested in. Find their names and pages by searching hashtags and then "like" as many things they have posted that appeal to you. Don't just "like" \(\mathbf{p}\) one picture.

Comment once in a while on art you see posted — it carries more weight than just "liking" a post. If you like their art, like their technique or even if you have a question about the process they use, feel free to comment on their post. It can start a conversation and that is what Social Media is all about! There's nothing quite like having someone express an enthusiasm or show interest for your art and posts. Be the one to encourage first! It will be so rewarding. Reaching out to others will in turn make them curious about you and your social footprint. The interactions may even bring new friends into your life!

Be sure to create posts about any upcoming events you will be in — Post the photo of the event and details of the location, time and date. When creating this post, make it sound exciting, like it's the thing to do or the place to be. Encourage people to bring their friends, family and neighbors. Make the event inviting by using your creativity with words and photos. Make people so curious that they will attend!

Don't forget – post on a regular basis – this will keep your followers engaged and interested in you and your art. Be sure to share our sites (FSVAA) with your friends and family.
